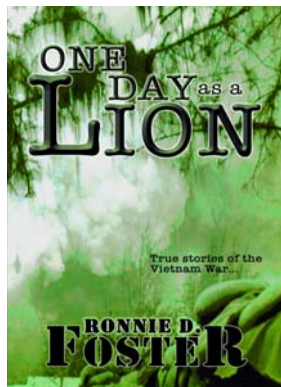


Last Train Running—R.D. Foster

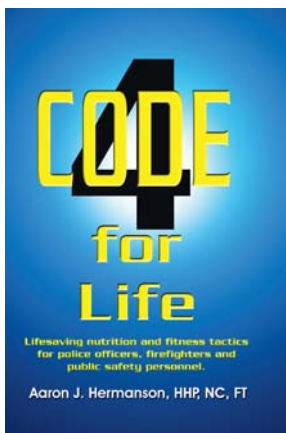


One Day As A Lion— R.D. Foster

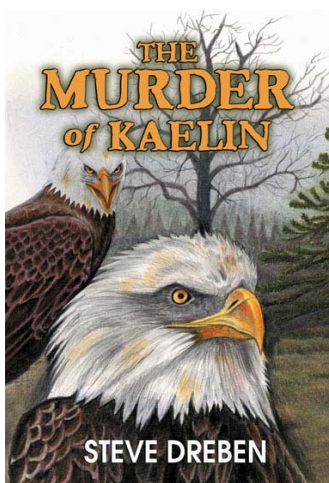
